

Norham St Ceolwulf's CE First School Sports Funding: 2023 – 2024

In 2023-2024 we will receive approximately £16230 P.E. and School Sport Funding. We are proposing to spend the amount in the following ways:

Amount	What we will do	Why are we planning this?
£10,000	Employ specialist P.E. teachers and coaches.	To employ specialist teachers and coaches through the NUFC Foundation to deliver a weekly P.E. lesson from Years 1-4. To continue to provide new and existing staff the opportunity to work alongside specialist teachers and coaches to continue to further develop their CPD in teaching P.E. To continue to provide an opportunity for pupils to work with specialist teachers and coaches, developing more links to local community clubs.
£950	Bought Yoga Bugs Virtual Membership.	To ensure provision for physical and mental well-being. To highlight the link between physical and mental well being for pupils.
£700	Partner with another school to run inter school competitions.	To raise the profile of and increase participation in inter school competitions. To subsidise increasing transport costs.
£1000	Provide at least one physical/sporting after school club.	To provide different physical/sporting after school clubs to encourage and engage more children to be physically active and to experience a range of physical activities and sports.
£1200	Purchase equipment for Forest Schools initiative. Contribute towards CPD for Forest Schools.	To access CPD and appropriate materials to develop children's mental and physical well being. To further develop the Outdoor and Adventurous curriculum offer. To develop pupils' confidence and self -esteem.
£600	Subsidise the Y4 end of year outdoor and adventurous trips.	To reduce the cost to parents so all children can participate in the residential/end of year trips. The trip includes many outdoor and adventurous activities and develops teamwork.
£330	Provide supply for PE. lead to develop and organise intra and inter school festivals and competitions. Provide supply for P.E. lead to continue to develop Sports Leadership within the school.	To provide intra school competitions during curriculum time. To organise a wide range of inter school festivals to be held virtually. In partnership with the School Games Organiser, develop competition for all sporting abilities. To include a wide range of competitions to suit all sporting interests. To further develop and to sustain a Sports Crew to work alongside the School Council (organisation of intra school competition). To develop sports leadership within lessons.
£750	Purchase additional sports resources and equipment.	To ensure children continue to be physically active throughout the school day. To promote social skills and to give children the opportunity to learn new games and skills. To ensure pupils have access to quality equipment to use in lessons and during after school clubs. To replace broken equipment.



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		To ensure the Sports Leaders have suitable equipment when leading group activities.
£700	Funds to pay for School Games competitions and travel to competitions.	To enable children to attend inter school festivals (School Games).

Sport Premium Sustainability

Wherever possible the PE and Sport Premium is used to create sustainable improvements and will benefit current pupils and pupils joining the school in future years in PE and School Sport by:

CPD for Staff

- Providing opportunities to continue to develop staff skills, knowledge and confidence which will impact on future cohorts of children, including ECTs.

Improving Community Links

- Creating and sustaining meaningful links between the schools and community clubs where coaches deliver in schools, children are taken to the club for School Games competitions or children are supported to transition into community sport.

Health & Well-Being

- Introduce the Forest Schools initiative to further develop mental and physical wellbeing for all pupils and to enhance provision for Outdoor and Adventurous activities.
- Further develop the Commando Joe's initiative to further develop mental and physical wellbeing for all pupils and to enhance provision for Outdoor and Adventurous activities.

Partnership working

- Continue to re-establish links that have been made with local schools to organise inter-school competitions and to share good practice. Establish links with new schools to increase participation in inter school competitions.
